Guidelines on Application for a Special Effects Operator Licence

Applicants should read the following guidelines before completing the application form:

- 1. Under section 9 of the Entertainment Special Effects Ordinance Cap. 560 (the Ordinance), a person who has been provisionally recognised by the Commissioner for Television and Entertainment Licensing as a special effects operator (SEO) may apply to the Entertainment Special Effects Licensing Authority (Authority) for a special effect operator licence within 90 days of the commencement of the Ordinance which is scheduled on 16 March 2001, and the Authority may waive the requirements for examinations and assessment of the applicant's qualifications and experience.
- 2. The above waiver will lapse after 13 June 2001. Any provisionally recognised SEO who has not been issued with a SEO licence under the Ordinance cannot use any special effects materials after this date. In order to allow the Authority and the Police to assess the applicant's qualifications and to conduct the fit and proper check (see par. 3 below), please submit your application well in advance, and in any case no later than 13 May 2001.
- 3. In order to satisfy the Authority that the applicant is a fit and proper person to be a licensed special effects operator, the applicant is required to complete the Authorisation Form (Form 8) to authorise the Commissioner of Police to check the applicant's criminal record and disclose it to the Authority.
- 4. The applicant shall submit two recent colour photographs of size 1" x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " which should be taken within the last 6 months.
- 5. If you want to apply for another special effects operator licence of a different stream, please submit a separate application.
- 6. To facilitate the processing of a special effects operator licence application, the applicant shall make a payment for the special effects operator licence fee as soon as possible upon receipt of a General Demand Note (GDN) issued by the Special Effects Licensing Section (SELS). The payment methods are shown on the back page of the GDN. If the applicant would like to pay the fee by cash or crossed cheque, he/she should go to a convenience store or post office, where appropriate, to make the payment first and submit a copy of the payment receipt to the SELS staff for verification and filing before collecting the licence. A special effects operator licence may be issued subject to such terms and conditions, and the permitted scope of operation as the Authority thinks fit.
